

PUBLIC NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Village of North Haven will hold a public hearing on the 20th day of July 2021, at 5:00 P.M., at the Village Hall, Ferry Road, North Haven, New York, to consider the adoption of a Local Law as follows:

LOCAL LAW NO. OF 2021
A LOCAL LAW AMENDING VILLAGE CODE § 112-14

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH HAVEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT OF VILLAGE CODE § 112-4

§ 112-4 Penalties for offenses.

A. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a violation punishable by a fine not exceeding \$500 or by imprisonment not exceeding 15 days, or by both.

B. Any person who shall be convicted of a second or subsequent offence within 12 months shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by fine of not less than \$2,500 nor more than \$10,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 1 year, or by both.

C. Any person who shall perform construction work on weekends in violation of the provisions of this chapter shall be subject to the following additional provisions. Upon the first violation, a notice of violation shall be issued and work on the project shall immediately enjoin and recommence at such a time in accordance with the provisions of this Chapter. Upon a second violation, work on the project shall immediately enjoin for a period of two weeks. Failure to address a stop-work order in a timely manner may result in civil, criminal, or monetary penalties in accordance with the enforcement measures authorized in this chapter. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to prohibit persons from accessing projects in cases of emergency, as approved by the Building Inspector, to protect or safeguard equipment, materials, or project progress.

D. In addition to any other penalty provided in this chapter, any person convicted of committing an offense against a provision of this chapter shall be liable for any expenses incurred by the Village in the elimination or abatement of the violation.

E. In addition to any other remedy provided by law, the Village may bring an injunction action or proceeding to enforce this chapter.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State as provided by law.

All persons in interest will be heard by the Board of Trustees at the public hearing to be held as aforesaid and may appear in person or by representative. The Village Hall is accessible to handicapped persons.
